The pureJUSTICE summer internship, based in Cincinnati, OH, is designed to train undergraduate students in embracing a justice lifestyle while addressing one of the great evils of our time—sex trafficking—through the development of educational materials, awareness campaigns, and strategic partnerships. The internship may be particularly attractive to students contemplating careers in law, government, human rights, social work, communications, or missions.

ELIGIBILITY

Candidates must be between 18 and 23 years of age and, at the time of application, enrolled in an undergraduate degree program. Candidates also must be in agreement with the Apostles' Creed and possess a mature Christian faith.



PROGRAM DETAILS

Duration: The 8-week internship will commence June 18, 2012 and conclude August 10, 2012.

Outreach: Interns will be given writing and public speaking opportunities to raise awareness about the reality of sex trafficking and commercial sexual exploitation.

Professional Development and Spiritual Formation: Interns will work in a professional environment and attend meetings with public officials, academics, activists, clergy, and other professionals on topics such as anti-trafficking efforts, spiritual growth, social activism, leadership, education/career planning, and public speaking.

Compensation: Interns will be paid \$8/hour.



APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicants should submit a cover letter, a statement of faith (may be incorporated into cover letter), résumé (including current GPA), and two recommendation letters to Noel Bouché at noel@purehope.net or 800 Compton Road, Suite 9224, Cincinnati, OH, 45231, no later than Friday, March 16, 2012. Your cover letter should describe your interest in anti-trafficking work, your relevant skills, and how you believe this internship would advance your personal and professional development.
